

S lips trips and falls

- Keep walkways clear and your work area tidy
- Minimise trailing cables and tape down cables where they cross walkways
- Clean up spillages immediately



rt in public places

- Anticipate audience response/interaction
- Ensure your work is stable and secure

Fire

- Store flammable chemicals in the yellow metal containers in the studio
- Use oil filler radiators provided by the School. Candles or naked flames are never allowed in studio spaces. No smoking inside University buildings.
- Be careful using irons, glue and heat guns. Always turn them off when finished.



lectricity

- Get all portable electrical appliances e.g. lights or kettles tested, contact technicians for help
- Do not use damaged or faulty equipment. Electrical equipment should be designed for use with UK electrical supply.
- Report any concerns to staff

Chemicals

- Follow manufacturer's instructions for use
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment
- Dispose of waste chemicals in containers provided
